In attendance: 10 Members

Meeting was called to order by Vice President Steve Colvin at 11:01 am.

Minutes: were reviewed by Darlene Upcraft from the previous February 11, 2024 meeting. One correction was noted, under Financials, the net loss of -\$422.40 should have been for January not December. Financials: were read by Tammie Whaley. The net income for February was \$4,660.88. Motion to accept the Financial report was made by Karen Galloway and seconded by Jim Fowler. Motion carried.

Bell Jar Report: was given by Jack Vida. February monthly profit was \$2,756. Checks were written for two donations approved at last month's meeting.

Also, a check for \$461.24 was written for an exhaust fan for the patio. Motion by Ned Burdick and seconded by John Vander Veer to accept the bell jar report. Motion carried.

Queen of Hearts Report: was given by Steve Colvin. The current game is week 9. The total pot is \$2,145.

Membership: Jack Vida read the names of 15 new members approved by the Board at this morning's meeting (see attached).

Building report: was given by Roy Narish. Ned Burdick purchased an exhaust fan and a three-way switch for the patio from Grainger for a total cost of \$461.24. They will install it when the weather gets nicer. Roy said that there is some painting that could be done when the weather is warmer. Steve reported that the liquor permit (an addition to the bar license to have a bar in the pavilion) has been conditionally approved. The bar in the pavilion must be built and photos showing the completed alterations including the pavilion additional bar must be submitted to the State Liquor Authority within 90 days for approval. Denise is reviewing options for bars that are 9 feet long.

On Sunday March 17'* it is the annual Potato Walk to benefit St. Baldricks. The club will be participating this year and is happy to be able to help raise money for children with cancer. Monday April 8'° i5 the total solar eclipse and the club has sold out of all the tee shirts we had ordered but another order will arrive on March 18^t. Will also have eclipse glasses for our members that weekend, while the supplies last. From 4pm until 7pm Mike MacDonald will be the entertainment in the bar.
